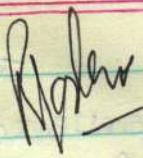
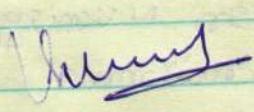


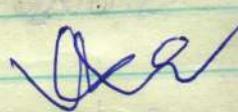
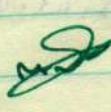
Governing Body meeting

The principal has informed the members that the extension of lab will be built during this year with all the required facilities.
3. Mr. m. sridhar, secretary & correspondent has informed the members for the construction of 2 new blocks beside both hostel i.e.,
