

Birsa Munda was not only a freedom fighter but also a social reformer and led the tribal movement known as Ulgulan (Revolt) against the exploitative systems of the British Colonial Government. He is also known as Dharti Abba because he urged tribal people to recognize their cultural origins and practice oneness.

PACE always takes the lead in observing notable individuals and their birth anniversaries firsthand. Dr. Sridhar, Secretary and Correspondent, gave some of his motivational ideas about Birsa Munda in honour of this exceptional person. "Despite having a brief life, Birsa Munda had a significant influence on the populace and India's freedom fight". Dr. GVK. 
