As a part of improving quality in the Teaching-Learning and Evaluation process of **PACE Institute of Technology and Sciences**, Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) conducted an online survey for the students named Student Satisfactory Survey-2020-21.

The Survey consists of 21 Questions. Out of these 21 questions, 20 questions are closed-ended questions, where students need to select the answer from the predefined options on a scale of zero to four, with the most positive response rated as four and the most negative response rated as zero. The responses to these questions were represented on the bar graph. Furthermore, a separate single bar graph of the average score of all the questions was indicated separately.

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






3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?


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


5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.









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





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










20. The overall quality of the teaching-learning process
